HVAC&R ARTICLE AWARD

AUTHOR OF AN ORIGINAL ARTICLE IN JOURNAL

PURPOSE

The HVAC&R Article Award is made to the author of an original article first published in the IRHACE Industry Journal, which the IRHACE Council considers to be the best of its kind for that year's issues.

Originally named the Keith McMillan -Journal Editors Award in September 1992 it was first presented in 1991. The name changed to the NZHEVAC Award for best original input to Journal in 2008.

The award takes the form of a certificate or individual trophy. Not necessarily awarded each year.

CATEGORY

• Nominated awards.

CRITERIA

• This award is presented for the best original input first published in the IRHACE Industry Journal.

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ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must meet the following eligibility:

- The article must be an original and not be published in any other digital or printed form.
- The nominee may be a member or non-member in the industry.
- Should more than one person have written the original article then all parties would be recognised individually.

NOMINATIONS

Nominations for the award are made by the IRHACE Council.

Should there be more than one nomination received in a calendar year, the IRHACE Council may follow a process to determine a successful candidate or choose to award to more than one candidate. IRHACE does not have to advise their process to either the successful or unsuccessful candidates.
