



# HVAC&R VOLUNTEER AWARD

## PROVIDING SUPPORT TO THE INSTITUTE

### PURPOSE

A person or persons who have most constructively and consistently provided support and service to the Institute. The HVAC&R Volunteer Award encompasses all volunteers across the Institute to recognise their time and efforts.

Previously this award was called the Branch Chair, Branch Service or NZHEVAC Award. In 2022, the IRHACE Council has chosen to replace these awards with the HVAC&R Volunteer Award so that it recognises all volunteers' efforts.

The award may take any form and change from year to year due to the number of winners and financial status of the Institute. Not necessarily awarded each year.

### CATEGORY

- Nominated awards

### CRITERIA

- This award is presented for the person or persons who consistently provide support and service to the HVAC&R Centre.

## ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must meet the following eligibility:

- The person or persons have given their time and effort as a volunteer during a calendar year.
- The nominee may be a member or non-member in the industry.
- More than one person may be nominated and receive this award during a calendar year.
- A person may receive this award more than once.

## NOMINATIONS

Nominations for the award are made by the IRHACE Council.

Should there be more than one nomination received in a calendar year, the IRHACE Council may follow a process to determine a successful candidate or choose to recognise some or all nominations. IRHACE does not have to advise their process to either the successful or unsuccessful candidates.
